

Prayer Guide for October 13

Acts 2:42–47

⁴² “And they devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. ⁴³ And awe^[a] came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. ⁴⁴ And all who believed were together and had all things in common. ⁴⁵ And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. ⁴⁶ And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.”

Learning Together (v.42)

- Ask God that our church family would be devoted to discussing and discovering Christ from the scriptures.
- Pray that we connect to Christ with others by participating in weekly worship gatherings.
- Pray our church grows in Christ with others through group involvement.

Building Relationships (v.42,44)

- Lord, guide our church would know, love and care for one another.
- Lord, help us to share what’s going on in our lives and support each other through prayer, care, affirmation and accountability.

Praying Together (v.42)

- Constantly ask God for an increase in our spiritual understanding, maturity, and fruitfulness.
- Ask God that a culture of prayer would permeate our church. That we would be saturated in prayer for and with one another.

Meeting Needs (v.45)

- Open our eyes to see the needs and hurts of those around us. Help us meet the needs and heal the hurts of others in the name of Jesus.
- Lead our church to give abundantly and joyfully, always ready to meet each other's material, emotional, and spiritual needs.
- Thank you, Lord, for all of your blessings. Help us to be willing to give up our time, money, or convenience to ensure that others have what they need.

Add to our numbers (v.47)

- Pray that our church would be a welcoming and friendly environment to newcomers.
- Ask God for our church to grow deeper in Christ and move wider into our community.
- Pray that our church will engage in spiritual conversations and pray for people where they live, work, play, eat, and go.
- Lord, give our church a spirit of boldness to share the Gospel with others in words and deeds.
